Hospitality: The swim banquet was a huge success. Thanks to Vickie and her committee. Yolanda's catering was very professional.

Golf Tournament: The tournament turned out to be a great success. Approximately \$15,000.00 profit. The players liked the location and the course.

The snack bar funds will be needed to restock many items.

NEW BUSINESS:

COACH'S REPORT:

Coach Stoll:

1. Extremely thankful to the Aquatics Board for all their hard work during the 2003- 2004 season
2. Thank you to the girl's water-polo tam for his end of season gift. It was really appreciated!
3. The weight room: approximately \$32,000 will be needed to update the weight room. The Aquatics program will need to donate approximately \$1,500.00.
4. 30 boys caps will be needed. Usually the boys athletic program helps to support, but this year our boosters will need to contribute.
5. Two new goals are needed: approximately \$1,300.00
6. Lastly: There was an unfortunate incident at a water-polo tournament between an El Toro player and another team member. Also there was an inappropriate parent interaction. Coach Stoll reviewed El Toro's professional philosophy of playing water polo. He would like to remind all parents that we must remember our attitude at the games. Parents are not to interfere with the referees or coaches. Three choices for parents: 1. Come to game and accept the referee's decisions, 2. Do not come to the game, or 3.
