The Charger Classic **El Toro Frosh - Soph Water Polo Tournament** **January 16 and 17, 2004**

- Pools:** El Toro High School, 25255 Toledo Way, El Toro
Trabuco Hills High School, 27501 Cordova Road/Mustang Run, Mission Viejo
- Schedule:** Each team in the tournament will play four games. All teams will play two games on Friday and two games on Saturday.
- Games:** CIF regulation five minute stop time with two minutes between quarters, halves and at time outs.
- Time Outs:** Each team will be allowed ONE time out per game in regulation and one in overtime. This rule applies to all games.
- Ties:** Ties in all games will be broken by the playing of sudden death periods of three minutes in duration. The game ends when a goal is scored.
- Warm Up:** Teams that are scheduled to play after the game in progress may warm up at any time in the shallow end of the pool. Coaches are to insure that all activity is safe.
- Forfeits:** Forfeits will be called five minutes after the scheduled game time if a team does not have seven eligible players in the game course ready to play.
- Equipment:** Bring your own warm up balls, towels and caps. Lockers are not available. Do not bring valuables.
- Awards:** A perpetual team trophy will be presented to the first place team.
- Fees:** The entry fee is \$220.00. Please make checks payable to El Toro High School. You may mail the checks to the school in care of Jeff Grosse or Don Stoll.
- Scorekeepers:** Bring your own scorekeepers if you can. There will be a tournament scorekeeper who will keep a record of each game. The results of this year's tournament will be used to seed the tournament next year.
